The Kalaris brand, named after proprietor Gus Kalaris, evolved from Gus' love of the great wines of Burgundy and his passion for producing California wines reflective of the uniqueness and beauty of their terroir. The Chardonnay from Napa Valley and the Pinot Noir from Sonoma Coast are the impressive results of that mission.

Harvest Report: The 2011 growing season began with a wet winter and spring, which continued into mid-June. Summer was mild with few high heat spikes, but growers managed by opening vine canopies to ensure sunlight, warmth and good air circulation around the grape cluster. Fall provided ideal ripening conditions with dry, sunny weather. Because of the late weather break, wines of this harvest will see excellent color and elegant flavors.
