Harvest Report: The 2009 vintage started with a mild winter and cool spring. Late spring rains provided ample soil moisture going into the growing season. Weather conditions were ideal during bloom and encouraged good fruit-set and uniformity. Temperatures were moderate throughout most of the summer which helped flavor development. The end of August brought an end to weeks of fog and the return of clear, bright sunshine. This continued during most of September, delighting the vines. The results show in the finished wine.
