BACKGROUND

To commemorate the 20th anniversary of surpassing Lou Gehrig's consecutive game streak, Ripken has teamed up with Napa Valley's AXIOS winery to make a luxury Cabernet Sauvignon. The wine is named "2131" after Ripken's record-breaking number of consecutive games. One-third of the profits from the wine will be donated to the Cal Ripken Sr. Foundation, which supports at-risk youth through baseball related programs. This collectable wine is a limited run of 2,131 bottles and sold individually in wood-and-glass boxes.

This wine was produced in honor of Cal Ripken Jr's 2131st consecutive game played, breaking the record in September 1995. One hundred percent Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine is concentrated, still young, but with terrific density, richness, and concentration, although still playing it close to the vest. Opaque purple incolor, with plenty of creme de cassis, licorice, and subtle smoke and earth, the wine is full-bodied and beautifully pure and layered. The proceeds will be donated to The Cal Ripken Sr foundation, reaching over one million children.
