BACKGROUND

Worthy "Sophia's Cuvée" started in 2001 as a tribute to a Dad's exuberance for his daughter (now 26 and an integral part of Dad's companies). Worthy was created as a value in the luxury category. The very first vintage had the honor of being named in the top third of the Wine Spectator's TOP 100 list. Year in and year out, Worthy shows like wines triple the price and often beats \$150+ wines in blind tastings. The wine typically drinks well on release and has the balance and integrity for long term aging. Since inception, Worthy has been accepted as one of the world's best values and a truly luxury wine experience.
