**Harvest Report:** The 2010 growing season in Napa Valley began cool and wet, pushing bud break, flowering and fruit-set back by three weeks. Fortunately there was very little frost damage due to a lot of cloud cover. A cooler than normal summer brought about a later than average verasion. Good canopy management helped prevent damage to the grapes from a late August heat wave. Overall the 2010 vintage resulted in lower yields, but excellent fruit.
